

# CSM 2020 “Cheat Sheet” for Radio Operators

## Commercial radio setup

- Saturday: Zone = Mt Tremblant, channel = Operation MT
- Sunday: Zone = Lachute, channel = Operation Lachut
- Zone select with <P2>, channel select with <CH+>
- Keep vehicle running when transmitting
- Wait for the “talk permit” tone
- Say “over” at the end of transmission (no repeater courtesy beep)
- **CP staff may use FRS radios!**

## Alternate ham 2m frequencies

### Only if commercial radio is unavailable!!!

- Saturday (Mont Tremblant to Montebello)
  - VE2RBH, 145.41, neg offset, CTCSS 123.0
  - VE2CRA, 146.94, neg offset, CTCSS 100.0
- Sunday (Montebello to Lachute)
  - VE2RM, 147.00, neg offset, CTCSS 103.5
- Both days, local simplex: 147.57, no offset or tone

- Commercial Ops channel if available
- Ham bands above if commercial radio NOT available
